

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe has a Tribal Government Improvement Grant, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Personnel Office was established and operated under this P.L. 93-638 Grant, and

WHEREAS, there is a need for a position inventory and training needs evaluation for additional improvement.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribal Chairman be authorized and directed to request technical assistance from the Bureau of Indian Affairs for assistance in the position inventory and training needs assessments.

The foregoing resolution was on February 2, 1978 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


