

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, a Sewer Lift Station is required in Whiteriver to lift the sewage into the upper Whiteriver ponds, and


WHEREAS, an easement is needed for the power supply and sewer line, and

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs is prepared to construct the needed facility.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that an easement be granted to the Bureau of Indian Affairs for the construction of the lift station and laying of 328 feet of cast iron force main.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the attached sketch showing the location be attached to and be made part of this resolution.


The foregoing resolution was on February 2, 1978 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
