

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Continental Telephone Company is interested in improving the telephone communications in Cibecue, and

WHEREAS, with the development of the new Community Center, Public Health Clinic, and Public Health Housing in Cibecue, these new developments cannot be served on the old system, and

WHEREAS, the Continental Telephone Company is considering to put a microwave system for Cibecue and also to serve the Carrizo Community, and

WHEREAS, the Continental Telephone Company has located six (6) locations required for this service, three (3) locations and three (3) alternates, and

WHEREAS, three (3) locations will be required which will provide the best service.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Continental Telephone Company be granted a lease on the final three (3) sites at the appraised value.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that before final consumation of the lease agreement that the Superintendent and the Tribal Chairman negotiate with the Continental Telephone Company for an agreed price.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the three (3) final locations be surveyed and appraised and a record be maintained in the Fort Apache Indian Agency Office.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman and Superintendent be authorized and directed to enter into a lease with the Continental Telephone Company for the location of the three (3) final selected sites to supply the communities of Cibecue and Carrizo.


The foregoing resolution was on February 2, 1978 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
