

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe has an approved budget for the Forestry Program (the Administrative Deduction) for FY 77-78, and

WHEREAS, there is a need to amend the line items of this budget but not the total budget because of a change in thinning practice, and

WHEREAS, the modification of this budget has been discussed by the Forestry Committee and they recommend that it be amended.


BE IT RESOLVED by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council that \$70,000.00 be reduced from the training and other expenses. Line item and \$70,000.00 be added to a line item for vehicle purchases.


The foregoing resolution was on February 2, 1978 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
