

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Whiteriver Unified Public School District No. 20 is entitled to apply for a grant for the special educational needs of Indian children in the amount of \$156,703.46 under the Indian Education Act of 1972, Title IV, Part A., and

WHEREAS, a properly and duly constituted body of Indian parents, teachers and secondary students have assessed the needs and developed a program in open consultation as the Title IV Parent Advisory Committee of Whiteriver Unified District No. 20, and

WHEREAS, a massive publicity campaign involving the Apache Hour broadcast, release of notice public hearing to all Indian students in the district with a support release from the Tribal Education Department has been conducted with a final public hearing on January 26, 1978, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, in official session, has reviewed the proposal project.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe hereby approves and supports the Title IV, Part A. Program of the Whiteriver Unified Public School District No. 20 and request that it be funded.




