WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 69 was ratified in 1964, and

WHEREAS, the designated voting places was specified in Ordinance No. 69, and


WHEREAS, two locations, Carrizo Police Station and East Fork Police Station are now not existing, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has designated the voting places for Carrizo to be the Carrizo Community Center and East Fork to be the East Fork Community Center.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Community Center for Carrizo and the Community Center for East Fork is designated as the voting places for the 1978 Tribal Election.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that other places specified in Ordinance No. 69 approved in 1964 will remain unchanged.


The foregoing resolution was on February 14, 1978 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
