

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Mrs. Marjorie (Cody) Alo is attempting to get a Kentucky Fried Chicken business franchise on the reservation, and

WHEREAS, one of the requirements of the franchise is a commitment for a one-acre lease, and

WHEREAS, the council was undecided as to the appropriate location, and

WHEREAS, it was the feeling expressed by the council that the one-acre lease should be in an area adjacent to the new commercial center.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the council commit themselves to approximately a one-acre lease in the area adjacent to the commercial center for the establishment of the Kentucky Fried Chicken business that Mrs. Marjorie (Cody) Alo is requesting.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that when the final selection is made on the location determined, that the survey information is to be on file in the Superintendent's Office when the Land Board authorizes the designated lease.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Council authorizes and directs the Superintendent and the Chairman of the Tribal Council to initiate a business lease to Mrs. Marjorie (Cody) Alo that will reflect all of the special stipulations that are normally in the tribal member lease for the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

The foregoing resolution was on March 1, 1978 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
