

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council directed the Tribal Chairman to enter into a five-year agreement with the DNA-People's Legal Services, and

WHEREAS, the requirements of the agreement stipulate a five-year lease at a specified rental rate for a five-year period.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Superintendent and Tribal Chairman be authorized and directed to enter into a five-year lease with the DNA-People's Legal Aid Services.


BE IT RESOLVED that the appraisal requirement be waived for this five-year period and that the rental rate be as specified in the final agreement signed by the Tribal Chairman.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the area is to be surveyed and described and the starting date of the lease is to be the same as the starting date on the agreement.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the final agreement as signed by the Tribal Chairman be attached to and made a part of this lease.

The foregoing resolution was on March 1, 1978 duly adopted by a vote of 1 abstd. 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
