

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is aware that the contract for the Tribal Attorney and General Counsel expires on March 31, 1978, and

WHEREAS, the Council desires a ninety-day extension of the contract, and


WHEREAS, this ninety-day extension would be under the same terms and conditions as the present contract, and


WHEREAS, this action is taken to alleviate particular pressures in the upcoming Tribal Election.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Superintendent is authorized and directed to seek an extension of approximately ninety (90) days for the months of April, May and June, 1978 for the extension of the Tribal Attorney and General Counsel contract.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Council presently feels that this is adequate time for the appropriate action and if action is not taken, by the expiration of this extension, additional extensions of ninety-day periods are authorized.

The foregoing resolution was on March 1, 1978 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (d) & (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
