

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the White Mountain Apache Tribe empowers the Tribal Council to appoint a qualified person to fill the office of Secretary of the Tribal Council; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has discussed and reviewed the qualifications necessary and expected for fulfillment of the duties of such office; and


WHEREAS, Mrs. Mary C. Endfield has faithfully served the Tribal Council as its Secretary for approximately 29 years, and has proven highly competent in fulfilling the duties of such position with the efficiency and capability necessary to the proper functioning of the Tribal Council.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe hereby re-appoints Mrs. Mary C. Endfield to serve as Secretary of the Tribal Council, and to continue fulfilling the duties and obligations of such office necessary to the proper functioning of the Tribal Council.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this appointment directed herein shall be for a term of four years, beginning this date, through April, 1982, or until such time thereafter as a successor may be appointed.

The foregoing resolution was on May 10, 1978, duly adopted by a vote of 6 for and 5 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 4 of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984).
