RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Constitution and By-Laws of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in Article III, Section 2 gives the power to the Tribal Council to pass ordinances which are consistent with and pursuant to the constitution governing future membership, loss of membership and the adoption of members by the White Mountain Apache Tribe, subject to review and approval of the Secretary of the Interior, and
- WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 3 was adopted on November 5, 1939 for adoptions into the membership of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, and that a unanimous vote of the Tribal Council shall be final in the adoption of new members, and
- WHEREAS, the attached list of twenty-three (23) individuals were adopted in the membership of the White Mountain Apache Tribe per Ordinance No. 3, and
- WHEREAS, the minutes of the meetings when these adoptions took place are not explicit or unavailable.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribal Council Meetings be reaffirmed that the adoption of the twenty-three (23) individuals did indeed take place and that they are members of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on May 10, 1978 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 2 of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
