

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the plan for use and distribution of the Western Apache Judgment Funds awarded in Docket 22-D published in the Federal Register on January 13, 1976 set aside eighty-percent (80%) of the judgment fund principal, and its accrued interest, for per capita distribution to all tribal members born on or prior to and living on December 3, 1975, and

WHEREAS, the membership roll shall be brought current under existing tribal procedures, and

WHEREAS, the proposed membership roll was posted for a period of thirty (30) days, and

WHEREAS, the accounting of the Base Roll of January 1, 1938 has been made, and

WHEREAS, the Enrollment Committee reviewed the accounting of the Base Roll on May 8 and 9, 1978 and the accounting is close to accurate and recommended that the attached list of changes be made to reflect the current membership roll.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the attached changes be made in the Base Roll of January 1, 1938.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the current membership roll for use in distribution of funds in Docket 22-D, is hereby approved and that the changes in the current roll be made to reflect the base roll.


The foregoing resolution was on May 10, 1978 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
