

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the Tribal Health, Education and Welfare Committee has recommended to the Tribal Council that the Cibecue Day School is expanded to include the Ninth Grade, and

WHEREAS, represented in the Health, Education and Welfare Committee meeting were the citizens of the Cibecue Community and desire to expand the Cibecue Day School to include the Ninth Grade in September, 1978.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Bureau of Indian Affairs be requested to expand the Cibecue Day School at the earliest possible time to include the Ninth Grade.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that when this expansion is completed that an adequate fulltime ceiling allowance be assigned by the Assistant Secretary of the Interior, Forrest Gerard, to adequately staff the teaching facility; also, living quarters should be made available.

The foregoing resolution was on May 11, 1978 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
