WHEREAS, the position of Tribal Trapper had been vacated by Mr. Lynn Cody, and


WHEREAS, under the CETA Program Mr. Lynn Cody trained Wilbur Dale to be an assistant trapper, and

WHEREAS, Mr. Cody informed the council that Wilbur Dale was qualified and eligible for the position as Tribal Trapper.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Wilbur Dale be appointed to the position of Tribal Trapper and to work under the supervision of the Manager of the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the salary be as established and that this position is considered as a full time Tribal position, effective May 11, 1978.


The foregoing resolution was on May 11, 1978 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
