

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Chaghache Day Care Parent Advisory Board has requested assistance from the Tribal Council, and

WHEREAS, this assistance is in the form of lumber to build shades, climbing decks, repair slides and shelves to be used by the children in the Day Care Center, and

WHEREAS, the Day Care Center is a non-profit organization and unable to procure immediate supplies, and

WHEREAS, the estimated cost as quoted by Fort Apache Timber Company is \$543.72.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the council authorizes and request the Fort Apache Timber Company to donate \$543.72's worth of lumber to the Chaghache Day Care Center for the proposed construction.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Fort Apache Timber Company is authorized to reflect this donation in the Fort Apache Timber Company accounting system as being a donation and uncollectible.


The foregoing resolution was on May 11, 1978 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
