

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the past winter season has necessitated increased energy consumption by White Mountain Apache Tribal members in order to adequately heat their homes, and

WHEREAS, the increased cost in securing additional energy has resulted in economic hardship for the elderly and low-income members of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, and

WHEREAS, Federal Emergency Energy Assistance funds are available through the Arizona Department of Economic Security to assist and relieve the elderly and low-income Tribal members from the previously mentioned economic hardship resulting from increased energy cost.

BE IT RESOLVED that the White Mountain Apache Tribe, through its Tribal Council, desires to contract with the Arizona Department of Economic Security for funds available under the Federal Emergency Energy Assistance Program (EEAP) in order to provide economic assistance and relief for elderly and low-income Tribal members.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman, on behalf of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to contract with the Arizona Department of Economic Security for Federal Emergency Energy Assistance funds.


The foregoing resolution was on May 25, 1978 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
