

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Guidance Center is co-ordinating the establishment of a home for the elderly on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Tribal Council to extend the help of the Tribe in this project, and

WHEREAS, funds are needed to purchase bedding, kitchen equipment and other items.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that \$5,000.00 be given to the Guidance Clinic for the above purposes and that said \$5,000.00 be obtained from the contingency fund within the Tribal Budget.


The foregoing resolution was on May 25, 1978 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
