

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Guidance Clinic has received funds through the Northern Arizona Comprehensive Guidance Center for the construction of a clinic to house the activities of the center on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and

WHEREAS, plans and specifications have been prepared and the project released for open competitive bidding, and

WHEREAS, the bid received exceeded the amount available from the Northern Arizona Comprehensive Guidance Center by \$60,000.00, and

WHEREAS, the facility is badly needed on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation to continue and expand the work being performed by the Guidance Center with Tribal members.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that an amount not to exceed \$60,000.00 necessary to complete the construction of the guidance facility is hereby appropriated from Revenue Sharing Funds received by the Tribe in 1978. Such funds are to be expended by the Tribal Treasurer upon receipt of such information as he may require to assure that the funds expended are utilized for the original construction design.


The foregoing resolution was on May 25, 1978 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
