RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Contract for the General Counsel of the White Mountain Apache Tribe expired on April 30, 1978, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council requested an extension of ninety (90) days, and
- WHEREAS, after council consideration and indicating that the General Counsel has performed well and done an excellent job these past three years and they are interested in a new contract, and
- WHEREAS, the term of the new contract was to be effective June 1, 1978 for a three-year period, and
- WHEREAS, other terms and conditions were to be negotiated between the Tribal Chairman and the General Counsel, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council agrees to accept the terms and conditions acceptable to both parties.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman be authorized to negotiate a three-year contract with Mrs. Kathleen Rihr Price be effective June 1, 1978.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Superintendent be furnished with adequate copies of the final, signed and negotiated contract.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the effective date be June 1, 1978 and expiration be May 31, 1981.

The foregoing resolution was on May 25, 1978 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (d) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
