

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 78-101 authorized the Tribal Work Experience Contract for Fiscal Year 1979, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council discussed the cost of mileage and transportation for the Tribal Work Experience Program, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council had directed the Tribal Chairman to raise the mileage cost from fifteen Cents (15¢) to Seventeen Cents (17¢) per mile, and

WHEREAS, this increase will minimize some of the loss incurred by the tribe in this program.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that for the Tribal Work Experience Program for Fiscal Year 1979 be requested that Bureau of Indian Affairs pay Seventeen Cents (17¢) per mile for transportation incurred under this contract.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the recontract budget being prepared reflect a mileage rate of Seventeen Cents (17¢) per mile.

The foregoing resolution was on June 13, 1978 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
