

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Tribal Council that the Living Waters Indian Mission of Cibecue is not under a permit, and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 65-116 authorized the Council and the Superintendent to enter into a revocable permit with this institution, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is still in agreement that the Living Waters Indian Mission may be issued a revocable permit and at the same term and conditions as the other established missions.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Bureau of Indian Affairs Agency Office will survey and identify the property now in use for the church building of the Living Waters Indian Mission.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman and the Superintendent are authorized and directed to enter into a revocable permit with the Living Waters Indian Mission of Cibecue.

The foregoing resolution was on June 13, 1978 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
