

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council desires to enter into a long-term lease with the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority, and

WHEREAS, this lease will be the 100 Mutual-Help Units in Project No. Ariz. 16-28, and

WHEREAS, it is the desires of the Tribal Council to improve the housing situation of the reservation.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribal Chairman and the Superintendent are directed to enter into a lease with the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority for those areas covered under Project No. Ariz. 16-28.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority submit to the Superintendent's Office each description and survey of the 100 units in Project NO. Ariz. 16-28.

The foregoing resolution was on June 13, 1978 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
