

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been specially requested by the family of Dempsey Altaha to assist them in securing transportation to visit him in El Reno, Oklahoma by authorizing their use of a tribal vehicle for such trip; and

WHEREAS, such tribal member's family agrees to provide all expenses of such transportation and trip but are unable to afford the vehicle necessary, without the Council's assistance; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council desires to assist such family, under such terms and conditions are understood and agreed upon between the family and the Tribal Chairman.

BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe hereby authorizes the use of a tribal vehicle by the immediate family of Dempsey Altaha, for the purpose of visiting him in El Reno, Oklahoma.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman is authorized and directed to make such arrangements, terms and conditions as are necessary pursuant to this resolution;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Council hereby specifically disclaims any and all liability of the Tribe in the use and operation of said vehicle while it is in the possession or control of any persons pursuant to the resolution and that it deems authorized drivers thereof responsible for any negligence in its use or operation.

The foregoing resolution was on July 13, 1978, duly adopted by a vote of eight (8) for and zero (0) against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
