

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is aware that there are presently overlapping youth activity programs under the Land Claims Office and the Athletic Department; and

WHEREAS, it is intended that the Land Claims Community Program shall continue to provide youth activities in communities on the Reservation, and such activities are divers and comprehensive.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that all youth activities presently undertaken by the Athletic Department be transferred to the Land Claims Program office of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on July 13, 1978, duly adopted by a vote of nine (9) for and zero (0) against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984).
