

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Fort Apache Agency, is acting so as to maintain any Bureau housing on the Reservation only within designated Bureau compounds; and

WHEREAS, presently, Bureau of Indian Affairs quarters 48-1, 48-2, and 50, in Whiteriver are located outside of the Agency compound, and the Bureau desires to transfer ownership of said quarters to the Tribe and is in extreme need of such structures.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe hereby accepts the transfer of B.I.A. quarters number 48-1, 48-2, and 50 to the ownership and possession of the Tribe.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents as may be necessary to effecuate said transfer.


The foregoing resolution was on July 14, 1978, duly adopted by a vote of nine (9) for and zero (0) against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
