

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to Council Resolution 78-03, has assumed the responsibility under P. L. 94-437 for its own health planning services from the Indian Health Service; and

WHEREAS, the Secretary of HEW has requested that Tribal Specific Health Plans, to be submitted to Indian Health Service Area Offices by July 1, 1979, address the last four years of P. L. 94-437, namely, 1981-1984; and

WHEREAS, the Health Plan of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, completed in January, 1978, covers the time period 1978-1980 and thus requires revision to meet Indian Health Service P. L. 94-437 guidelines.

BE IT RESOLVED that the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council requests funding from Indian Health Service, for the period October 1, 1978 to June 30, 1979 and under P. L. 93-638 grant authority, to cover the cost of revising the existing Tribal Health Plan to comply with IHS P. L. 94-437 guidelines.


The foregoing resolution was on July 14, 1978, duly adopted by a vote of nine (9) for and zero (0) against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
