FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe passed Resolution No. 78-127 on July 13, 1978 to provide air fare and camping fees to Davis Susan, Jr. as therein set forth, and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council desires to also provide one-way air fare to Therman Susan as a travelling companion to his brother Davis for the purposes provided in Resolution No. 78-127.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe hereby amends Resolution No. 78-127 to provide the amount of a one-way air fare to Therman Susan as a travelling companion to his brother Davis and further authorizes and directs the Tribal Business Office to pay said sum out of the Central Tribe Public Relations Budget.

The foregoing resolution was on July 26, 1978 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
