

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has discussed with the Indian Health Service Project Engineer, the regular priority list and unmet needs list of reservation improvement, and

WHEREAS, priorities were established to show the importance of this priority list.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Indian Health Service Plan and program on the basis of the priorities established and make every effort to get Public Health funds in the minimum amount of \$2,084,000.00 to complete this immediate priority list.

The foregoing resolution was on August 2, 1978 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
