

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Fair Commission Chairman discussed with the Council the upcoming Labor Day Fair and Rodeo, and

WHEREAS, it was requested that Friday, September 1, 1978 be declared a Tribal Holiday, and

WHEREAS, it was also requested that each tribal employee receive a check in the amount of one week's pay as partial payment on that pay period, and

WHEREAS, this check would be received by August 31, 1978.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribal Chairman to be granted the authority to declare September 1, 1978 a Tribal Holiday.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the Tribal Chairman arrange with the Finance Office and Payroll Section to issue the one week check prior to the closing time on August 31, 1978.


The foregoing resolution was on August 2, 1978 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
