

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Christmas Tree Lake was to be managed for recreation income purposes, and the propagation of Salmo Apache Arizona Native Trout, and

WHEREAS, the population of Salmo Apache Trout in Christmas Tree Lake is once again at a harvestable level, but due to natural reproduction, the Recreation Enterprise is recommending that this lake be opened to fishing on a limited basis.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the attached Management Plan for 1978 be followed as it allows, for the best use of the resource.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the continual upgrading of the fishery resources on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation requires monetary input; therefore, anyone fishing on this lake during the season must have, in their possession, a Special Christmas Tree Lake Permit costing \$10.00 per day.

The foregoing resolution was on August 2, 1978 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (f) and (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).

October 14 - 22, 1978.

Fishing Methods

Artificial flies and lures only.

Boats with electric motors only.

Fish Limit

3 Arizona Native Trout. 14" or larger.

7 Salmo Trutta Brown Trout. No size limit.

Price

\$10.00/Day/per person (Tribal or Non Tribal).

Special Christmas Tree Lake Permit Required.

People Limit

50 people/day

The first 50 people to purchase the
special permits for specific dates
will be allowed on the lake.

All permits will be sold through
the White Mountain Recreation
Office in Whiteriver.
