

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Mr. Grobin Davis has requested permission from the Tribal Council for transfer of traders permit and tribal business license, and

WHEREAS, the proposed new owner would be Mr. John P. Ledbetter of Phoenix, Arizona, and

WHEREAS, Mr. Ledbetter is going to be operating the same basic business as Mr. Davis.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Superintendent be authorized to issue to Mr. John P. Ledbetter of Phoenix, Arizona, the necessary traders permit providing that Mr. Ledbetter files the necessary applications and is qualified for traders permit.

The foregoing resolution was on August 2, 1978 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
