FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, Mrs. Winona Nosie discussed with the Tribal Council the undesirable location where the Housing Authority is to construct her house, and


WHEREAS, Mrs. Nosie requested that the Tribal Council intercede with the Housing Authority and move to a satisfactory location, and

WHEREAS, this new location is south and adjacent to a Mutual Self-Help House owned by Logan Duryea.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribal Council agrees with Mrs. Winona Nosie and will attempt to have the Housing Authority move the construction site to the requested location.

The foregoing resolution was on September 13, 1978 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 2 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
