WHEREAS, Genevieve Endfield discussed with the Tribal Council, the need to change the title of the Office of the Land Claims Community Recreation, and

WHEREAS, the proposed new title would be, "APACHE YOUTH RECREATION", and

WHEREAS, this change is needed to eliminate the confusion between the Land Claims Programs and the Tribe's Youth Program.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Land Claims Recreation Program be changed to a new title of Apache Youth Recreation.


The foregoing resolution was on September 13, 1978 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
