

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Sunrise Operating Budget for 1978-79 had been returned on two occasions, and
- WHEREAS, since May 1, 1978, starting the new Fiscal Year, the Sunrise Complex has had little operating money, and
- WHEREAS, Sunrise does not have the funds to operate on during the first eight (8) months of the Fiscal Year, and
- WHEREAS, the final draft of the proposed Sunrise Budget was reviewed by the Finance Committee and the Tribal Council and they have recommended no change in the previous submission, and
- WHEREAS, a total amount of \$1,839,128.00 is requested, and
- WHEREAS, the Council desires to advance \$300,000.00 to the Sunrise Complex for operating funds for the 1978-79 season.
- BE IT RESOLVED that funds in the amount of \$300,000.00 be advanced from the Central Tribal Budget to the Sunrise Complex.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this \$300,000.00 will be returned to the Central Tribe as available.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman is authorized and directed to amend the Central Tribal Budget.

The foregoing resolution was on September 13, 1978 duly adopted by a vote of 1 abst. 7 for and 2 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) and (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
