

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Adam Lupe discussed with the Tribal Council his desires to enter into a business, and

WHEREAS, he requested a business lease on Lot C-31 of the Hondah Sub-Division, and

WHEREAS, this location would be good and accessible from both the reservation and non-reservation areas.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman and Superintendent are authorized and directed to enter into a business lease with Adam Lupe for Lot C-31 of the Hondah-Homesite Sub-Division.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this member business lease be on the same terms and condition as the other business leases and shall only require a federal traders license.


