

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, at the Regular Council Meeting on July 13, 1978, Resolution No. 78-133 was approved, and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 78-133 was in error, and

WHEREAS, this resolution is being passed to rescind the action of July 13, 1978, and

WHEREAS, the attached community budget for the funds appropriated for recreation in the communities from the Land Claims Funds has been presented to the following communities in an open meeting and voting of the community residents:

1. Carrizo Community	\$24,809.00
2. Cedar Creek Community	15,761.00
3. Cibecue Community	22,280.00
4. McNary Community	11,357.00
5. Seven Mile Community	16,493.00
6. Canyon Day Community	25,140.00
7. East Fork Community	19,530.00
8. Whiteriver Community	21,460.00
9. Northern District (North Fork, Diamond Creek, Rainbow City Communities)	28,265.00

and

WHEREAS, the above communities by a majority vote of those present at the community meetings have approved this proposed budget, and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Tribal Council to institute this program and budget in accordance with the desires of these communities.

BE IT RESOLVED that the attached budget for the aforementioned Communities Recreation Program is approved for each community listed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the funds to initiate these programs be appropriated as needed by the Central Accounting Office from the Lands Claims Funds on deposit with the United States Government in order to fund the Recreation Program in the above communities.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Resolution No. 78-133 is rescinded in its entirety.


