

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that tribal member, David Bush made application for a house with the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority under Project No. ARIZ. 16-28, and

WHEREAS, his application was denied when the Authority discovered that the site he chose for construction of such a house is subject to potential flooding from the East Fork river, and

WHEREAS, said tribal member is entitled to reside on land of his choice on the reservation, within reason, and is in need of a house under this funding project, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has received and discussed remedies to the potential flooding in the area where Mr. Bush has selected a homesite; including possible diversion or diking, in case of a flood, so that his application for a house may be reconsidered by the Housing Authority.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it shall seek all possible sources of funding and Bureau of Indian Affairs assistance in establishing a diversion or diking system which would alleviate potential flooding on the homesite selected by tribal member, David Bush, in his application for a house under Project No. 16-28.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Council directs that the application of David Bush for a house under Project No. ARIZ 16-28 with the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority be reconsidered by the Housing Authority in consideration of the Council's directives hereinabove stated.

The foregoing resolution was on November 08, 1978 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
