

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the cutting expiration date on the following described logging units will expire on December 31, 1978:

WHEREAS, these logging units are under contract to the Fort Apache Timber Company, and

WHEREAS, the Fort Apache Timber Company has requested that the contract date be extended to permit them enough time to harvest the remaining timber that should be logged, and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Tribe to extend these dates to allow the Fort Apache Timber Company to finish cutting and perform other contract obligations.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe consents to extend the cutting expiration dates and the contract expiration dates for other sale obligations on these logging units as follows:
