



RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has been repeatedly advised of numerous complaints from the employees concerning the Acting Managers of Hondah Service Station, Grocery Store and Hotel, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that said Acting Managers have not maintained a satisfactory work performance based on the complaints made and the disruption of employer and employee relationship caused by said managers, and
- WHEREAS, such disruption has seriously impeded the proper and efficient operation of the Enterprise, and
- WHEREAS, it is immediately necessary for the Tribal Council to act to remedy this problem.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe hereby directs and authorizes the Tribal Chairman and the Chairman of the Board of Directors of the Apache Enterprise to terminate the employment of Ted and Holly Pappas through the General Management of the Apache Enterprise, effective immediately.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Council directs the General Management of the Apache Enterprise to undertake any and all steps necessary to continue the proper and efficient management of the Hondah businesses until such time as the permanent manager returns from vacation as directed by the Apache Enterprise Management.

The foregoing resolution was on November 17, 1978 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
