RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has discussed the need for the recreation of the tribal members, and
- WHEREAS, many adults and many students are interested in utilizing the Sunrise Ski Resort as recreation, and
- WHEREAS, the Ski Training Program has been included in most of the school athletic and physical fitness program.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that they feel that to encourage good physical fitness and good recreational outlets for tribal members, that special rates should be established by the Tribal Council for tribal members.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Enterprise of the Sunrise Complex be directed to offer the following schedule to bona-fide tribal members. This schedule will be:

\$4.00 per day on rental equipment

\$4.00 per session of ski school

\$5.00 per day on lift tickets

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that these rates will be initated upon receipt of this resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on December 13, 1978 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934(48 Stat. 984).
