RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe currently has a contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs under P. L. 93-638 for Home Improvement Program housing, and
- WHEREAS, the original application provided \$100,600.00 for remodeling sixteen (16) houses at a cost not to exceed \$2500.00 per unit and eleven (11) new units, and
- WHEREAS, it has been determined that it is impossible to comply with Federal remodeling requirements for a unit cost of \$2500.00 and further that construction costs now will require approximately \$12500.00 per unit for new construction.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman or his authorized representative be instructed to negotiate with the Bureau of Indian Affairs to modify the existing contract to provide for the construction of eight (8) new housing units with the selection of the individual participants to be furnished based on selection according to need by a consistee of the Tribal Council.

The foregoing resolution was on February 07, 1979 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
