

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is vitally aware of the serious and extensive flood damage to the property of numerous persons within the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and
- WHEREAS, such recent flood damage has destroyed a variety of property interests including farmlands, irrigation ditches, private homes, roads, access to residential areas, tribal businesses, livestock property and recreational areas, and
- WHEREAS, the seriousness of such flood damage amounts to extreme losses in money and perspective development by the tribe and individuals injured by the flood damage, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is fully aware that the Bureau of Indian Affairs and the Federal Disaster Assistance Administration have specific responsibilities to the tribe in providing all necessary relief from this flood damage, and
- WHEREAS, to date, little or no action has been taken by either agency to provide such emergency assistance.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby urgently demands immediate assistance to the tribe and tribal members from the Bureau of Indian Affairs and the Federal Disaster Assistance Administration for relief from the extensive and costly flood damages recently suffered on the reservation.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman or his authorized representative is hereby delegated the responsibility of taking all necessary actions to carry out the purposes of this resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on February 07, 1979 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
