- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is advised that the Whiteriver Unified Public School District No. 20 is entitled to apply for a grant for the special educational needs of Indian children, in the amount of \$204,736.33, under the Indian Education Act of 1972, Title IV, Part A., and
- WHEREAS, a properly and duly constituted body of Indian parents, teachers and secondary students have assessed the needs and developed a program in open consultation as the Title IV Parent Advisory Committee of Whiteriver Unified District No. 20, and
- WHEREAS, a massive publicity campaign involving the Apache Hour braodcast, release of notice of public hearing to all Indian Students in the district with a support release from the Tribal Education Department has been conducted with a final public hearing on January 24, 1979, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, in official session, has reviewed the proposed project.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe hereby approves and supports the Title IV, Part A Program of the Whiteriver Unified Public School District No. 20 and requests that it be funded.

The foregoing resolution was on February 07, 1979 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
