## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is advised that the Tribal Health Authority has submitted, for the third time in two years, a proposal to the Phoenix Area Indian Health Service Office for a Public Law 93-638 Health Education Contract, and
- WHEREAS, it is intolerable to delay this needed service for our people and the future.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe demands immediate consideration of and action on the Health Authority proposal for a Comprehensive Community Health Education Program, to begin no later than May 01, 1979 to run for a period of nine (9) months and funded in the amount of \$69,348.00.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman is directed and authorized to negotiate immediately the terms of this program contract.

The foregoing resolution was on March 13, 1979 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
