RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe was presented a report of the extensive and dedicated efforts of the Whiteriver Elementary School Sixth Grade to earn their own way to San Diego, California, and
- WHEREAS, such Sixth Grade Class has been invited by the City of San Diego to represent the White Mountain Apache Tribe during such visit to the City on May 15, 1979, and
- WHEREAS, these Sixth Grade students collected some \$4,800.00 by their own work efforts, in order to pay for such trip, but have recently found that this amount is some \$1500.00 short of the amount needed to go, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council highly commends the initiative and self-reliance of these young people in setting a goal and persistently following through on it on their own.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes and directs the payment of \$1500.00 to the account of the Whiteriver Elementary School Sixth Grade Class, or person authorized to act on its behalf, for the purpose of supplementing the amount necessary to send the Class to San Diego, California on behalf of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, as herein referenced.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that said payment is to be made from the Contingency Fund of the Central Tribe Budget, Fiscal Year, 1978-79.

The foregoing resolution was on April 04, 1979 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
