RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe provides public announcements over the radio, denoted "The Apache Hour", as a service to the White Mountain Apache people, and
- WHEREAS, the public service nature of these announcement requires the establishment of criteria, regulations or restrictions regarding their content in the public interest, including the restriction from announcements solely in the private interest of anyone authorized to conduct The Apache Hour.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache
 Tribe that it hereby authorizes and directs the Office
 of the Tribal Chairman to establish criteria, regulations
 or restrictions regarding the announcements authorized
 over "The Apache Hour" radio in the public interest.

The foregoing resolution was on April 04, 1979 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
