RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is advised that it was impossible to submit the Tribal budgets to the Bureau of Indian Affairs within the ten-day limit prescribed by the Tribal Constitution and By-Laws, due to the necessity of cross-checking all calculations for possible errors, and


WHEREAS, in several Enterprise budgets, addition errors were found and corrected, which did not significantly alter the budgets as presented to the Tribal Council.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribal and Enterprise Budgets are hereby re-affirmed in the following amounts:
