RESOLUTION OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
AGENCY FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION
WHITERWER, ARIZ.

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has been reminded of its commitment to reimburse the Administration for Native Americans (ANA) Program for Federal funds expended for ANA sponsored Youth Program during 1978, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that such funds have not yet been reimbursed in the amount of \$1,299.30.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes and directs that the ANA Program be reimbursed by the Tribe in the amount of \$1,299.30 for ANA sponsored Youth Program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman is authorized to make said payment from appropriate Central Tribal funds available.

The foregoing resolution was on May 03, 1979 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
