## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe d/b/a White Mountain Apache Development Enterprise currently is undertaking housing and other construction projects on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and
  - WHEREAS, the Tribal Council reviewed and discussed the advantages to the Tribe of providing all concrete necessary for construction projects on the reservation, and
  - WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe d/b/a White Mountain Apache Development Enterprise has completely discontinued the purchase of concrete from previous suppliers who reportedly controlled the cement allocations of Arizona Cement Companies within the geographical area of the reservation, and
  - WHEREAS, the Tribal Council desires to obtain a fair cement allocation directly to the Tribe within the reservation; for the purposes of providing all concrete necessary for construction projects on the reservation.
  - BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe hereby directs that its Enterprise, White Mountain Apache Development Enterprise, undertake all actions necessary to replace all previous supplies of concrete to the Tribe by obtaining a fair cement allocation directly to the Tribe, for the purposes of allowing the Tribe to supply necessary concrete for all construction projects on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

The foregoing resolution was on May 03, 1979 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
