

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Recreation Enterprise has suffered serious damage to its roads and recreation facilities as a result of flooding and heavy snowfall during the period from March, 1978, to March, 1979; and

WHEREAS, the Economic Development Administration, under its Public Works Impact Program, has invited an application from the White Mountain Apache Tribe for funding to restore roads and facilities damaged by snow and flood conditions; said application to be submitted as soon as possible;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe hereby authorizes the submittal of a grant application to EDA for the above stated purposes; and that the Tribal Chairman be authorized to take such actions as are necessary to accomplish the intent of this resolution.


The foregoing resolution was on May 24, 1979, duly adopted by a vote of 6 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
